## The animal of the end times

Daniel 7; Revelation 13;

The four animals from Daniel chapter 7 as well as the animal from Revelation chapter 13 are one and the same.



## The look:

Both animals come from the sea.

The beast of Revelation 13 contains all the symbols of the four beasts of Daniel 7, namely, Pardel, Leo, and Bear.



The four animals of Daniel 7 have seven heads and ten horns together, just like the beast of Revelation 13.

In Daniel 7, the animals are listed individually and their activities are assigned to the individual animals.

In Revelation chapter 13 it is summarized as an animal.

## Daniel 7

- Dan 7:2 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.
- Dan 7:3 And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.
- Dan 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- Dan 7:5 And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and it had three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.
- Dan 7:6 After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.
- Dan 7:7 After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.

#### **Revelation 13**

**13:1** And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy. 13:2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

They blaspheme against God and they are given three and a half years time

Dan 7:25 And he shall speak *great* words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

(The horn from the fourth animal)

- **Off 13:5** And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty *and* two months.
- **Off 13:6** And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.

# They fight against the holy gods and defeat them

Dan 7:21 I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;

Off 13:7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

#### The animal is burned with fire

**Dan 7:11** I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld *even* till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

Off 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

The scenario of the animals takes place in the end times, before the second coming of Jesus.

Dan 7:13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, *one* like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

Dan 7:14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion *is* an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom *that* which shall not be destroyed.

Off 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

Horn = king

Dan 7:27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

It is the time of the end.

# The four beasts of Daniel chapter 7 are all on earth at the same time. The first three animals will be removed after the fourth animal.

Dan 7:11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld *even* till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.

Dan 7:12 As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.

## Which nations are the animals?

#### 1st world:

As industrialized or industrialized countries English developed countries are generally referred to as technologically advanced states with significant domestic industrial production of goods. They contain an industrial society characterized by a highly specialized division of labor. One speaks also of the states of the first world.

Industrial states in the original sense were states that produced their economic power mainly from industrial production, in contrast to the agricultural states, in which agriculture predominated. The first state in the world to which this definition applied was Great Britain. There the beginnings of industrialization began at the end of the 18th century. In the 20./21. Century, the service sector became increasingly important worldwide.

#### 2nd world:

The term Second World referred to the real socialist countries of the Eastern Bloc in the Cold War era.

## 3rd world

At the Bandung conference on April 18, 1955, the present 29 countries from Asia and Africa took this title for themselves. They understood themselves as a union of poor countries, which fought not only for an economic betterment but also against colonialism and racism. In the choice of its own name as a "Third World" was already a different interpretation than the Original of Sauvy in the foreground: namely, the "Third World" as a union of those countries that belonged to any of the two power blocs of the Cold War. (These countries have chosen the name "Third World" for themselves, so it is not derogatory.)

## The first animal; the first world

Dan 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

The beginning of these states was England. The coat of arms of England is the lion. Later, the other European countries joined. They divided the world among themselves as Inperial Powers.

Age of imperialism (Wikipedia) The imperialism refers to the world power striving especially of the European great powers. It was created - concerning Europe - with Alexander the Great, but as the actual area is the time from 1880 to the First World War. One of the major factors of imperialism was colonization and the division of territories within and outside Europe, known as colonialism, to safeguard economic and political interests. Parallel to the intention to dominate the peoples of Africa, which are considered to be "underdeveloped", the ideology of social Darwinism was constructed in conjunction with the scientifically refuted theory of human races.

Today, instead, the term is often used for the so-called emerging countries, a group of countries that are about to abandon the status of a developing country and become an industrialized country; for example, the People's Republic of China and India. However, the meaning of the term has declined sharply since 1989, and the formerly widespread and controversial designations First World (for developed countries), Third World (for developing countries) and Fourth World (mostly for resource-poor developing countries or the so-called Least Developed Countries) have been used ever since less used. The concept gained popularity again as the concept of the Indian-American political scientist Parag Khanna, who understands countries that are in the geopolitical and geo-economic zones of influence of different empires.

# China and India have become major powers in the last 20 years. China even with the ambition of a world power.

Tiger countries are the economically fast-developing countries of South Korea, Taiwan and Singapore, as well as the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. The name, which was coined in the 1980s, comes from the fact that these four states or zones with high economic growth from developing countries became industrialized countries.
